The Novostone hinged, and sliding door showers offer 10mm safety glass and a solid surface acrylic base with a 110mm upstand, with built-in channel waste, glazing channels, and hardware. The standard hardware finish is chrome, although available in black, brushed brass, gun metal and brushed nickel. Available as a hinged or sliding Alcove or Corner. Sizes range from 1000mm to 1800mm.

Building code performance clauses

All relevant building code performance clauses are listed in this document:

B2 Durability

B2.3.1

Building elements must, with only normal maintenance, continue to satisfy the performance requirements of this code for the lesser of the *specified intended life* of the *building*, if stated, or:

• (c) 5 years if: the building elements (including services, linings, renewable protective coatings, and fixtures) are easy to access and replace, and failure of those building elements to comply with the building code would be easily detected during normal use of the building.

F2 Hazardous building materials

F2.3.1

The quantities of gas, liquid, radiation or solid particles emitted by materials used in the *construction* of *buildings*, shall not give rise to harmful concentrations at the surface of the material where the material is exposed, or in the atmosphere of any space.

F2.3.3

Glass or other brittle materials with which people are likely to come into contact shall:

- a. if broken on impact, break in a way which is unlikely to cause injury, or
- b. resist a reasonably foreseeable impact without breaking, or
- c. be protected from impact.

G1 Personal Hygiene



G1.3.2

Sanitary fixtures shall be located, constructed and installed to:

- a. facilitate sanitation,
- b. avoid the risk of food contamination,
- c. avoid harboring dirt or germs,
- d. provide appropriate privacy,
- e. avoid affecting occupants of adjacent spaces from the presence of unpleasant odours, accumulation of offensive matter, or other source of annoyance,
- f. allow effective cleaning,
- g. discharge to a plumbing and drainage system as required by Clause G13 Foul water when water-borne disposal is used, and
- h. provide a healthy safe disposal system when non-water-borne disposal is used.

G12 Water Supplies

G12.3.2

A potable water supply system must be-

- a. protected from contamination; and
- b. installed in a manner that avoids the likelihood of contamination within the system and the water main; and
- c. installed using components that will not contaminate the water.
